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SECTION 1.

SECTION 2.

2.1. LEGAL BASIS

SECTION 5.

5.1. SUPPORTING STUDENTS WITH DIVERSE EDUCATIONAL NEEDS

BSU recognizes that some learners may face additional challenges or require tailored approaches to fulfill their academic potential. We are committed to providing support for students with Special Educational Needs (SEN) by ensuring flexibility, accessibility, and personalized learning pathways.

The categories of students who may require additional support include, but are not limited to:

- Students with physical or mental disabilities;
- Students experiencing communication, emotional, or learning difficulties;
- Gifted and highly talented students;
- International students or those whose first language differs from the language of instruction.

Guided by the International Baccalaureate (IB) philosophy, BSU promotes both cultural diversity and individualized educational planning, ensuring that no learner is left behind.



5.2. PRINCIPLES OF INCLUSIVE EDUCATION AT BSU

BSU's inclusive education practices are built on the following foundational principles:

- **Continuity:** Students with SEN receive ongoing, adaptive support throughout all stages of their academic development.
- **Consistency:** All forms of support are implemented systematically, taking into account students' learning environments, family contexts, socio-emotional needs, and personal growth trajectories.
- **Emotional Well-being:** The university places high importance on fostering students' mental health, self-confidence, and emotional resilience as part of their overall educational success.
- **Differentiated Approach:** Teaching and support methods are tailored to individual students' strengths, challenges, and aspirations, recognizing that one size does not fit all.

5.3. INDIVIDUAL EDUCATION PLAN (IEP)

In order to provide targeted and meaningful support, BSU develops and monitors Individual Education Plans (IEPs) for students with identified SEN. Each IEP serves as a structured framework for personalized academic success and includes:

1. **Individual Characteristics:** A profile of the student's specific needs, such as disabilities, giftedness, or language-related challenges;
2. **Developmental Goals and Prioritized Tasks:** Clearly defined objectives aligned with the student's potential and educational trajectory;



3. Support Mechanisms: A set of tools, strategies, and resources that facilitate progress toward achieving the outlined goals.

IEPs are developed in close collaboration with academic advisors, support staff, and – where appropriate – the student and their family. These plans are systematically reviewed at least twice a year to ensure their continued relevance and impact.

SECTION 6.

6.1. CORE VALUES OF THE POLICY

This policy document ensures a dedication to the values of inclusivity and fair treatment of individuals related to Baku Slavic University, regardless of age, gender, religion, disability, ethnicity, economic status, political views, and other beliefs.
