On May 7–8, 2026, Baku Slavic University will host the 17th International Scientific Conference “Azerbaijan of the New Era,” dedicated to the 103rd anniversary of the birth of the National Leader Heydar Aliyev.

The main object of the conference is to provide an academic platform for an in-depth discussion of the ideological and political foundations of modern Azerbaijani statehood, the state-building legacy of Heydar Aliyev, the national identity model, the philosophy of sovereignty, and contemporary development strategies.

The conference will also focus on Azerbaijan’s political, economic, and social development, the region’s new geopolitical realities following the Karabakh Victory, issues concerning Western Azerbaijan, as well as current challenges in modern linguistics and literature. It will encourage the active participation of young researchers and contribute to the international visibility of Azerbaijani scholarship.

Requirements For Formatting Conference Papers (APA Style)

General guidelines:

Paper size A4, font size 12 pt, Times New Roman, margins 2 cm on all sides, line spacing 1.5, first-line paragraph indent 1.25 cm. Words should not be hyphenated at line breaks.

Structure and formatting requirements:

1. **Author's surname, first name, patronymic** (fully written, lowercase letters, bold, left-aligned).
2. **Academic degree, academic rank, affiliation, country, city, email address, ORCID iD** (fully disclosed, lowercase letters, regular font, right-aligned).
3. **Title of the article** (uppercase letters, bold, centered).
4. **Keywords** (5–7 words, in the language of the article and in English).
5. **Abstract** (up to 75–100 words, in the language of the article and in English).
6. **Article text** (up to 8 pages including all formatting).
7. **References** (alphabetical order). Citations in the text should indicate the source number and page(s) in brackets.
For example: [2] or [2; 5; 8] or [2; 14–15].
