Form 2. Article (placed after form 1)

Article structure and formatting rules:

1. Title of the article (in capital letters, bold, centered)
2. Author's name and surname (must be fully stated, in bold, on the left side)
3. Academic degree, academic title, place of work, country, city, e-mail address, ORCID ID (must be fully disclosed, in lowercase, regular font, on the right side)
4. Keywords (5-7 words, in the language of the article and in English)
5. Abstract (250 words, in the language of the article and in English)
6. Text of the article (up to 8 pages including all layout)
7. Bibliography (in alphabetical order). References to literature are given in the text in brackets with the number and page of the source. For example: [2] or [2; 5; 8] or [2; 14-15]

Information about the author and the article must be submitted in one file no later than March 20, 2026, by registering via the link <https://bsu-uni.edu.az/Elm/Seminar2>.

All submitted articles will be reviewed for the degree of originality of the author's text.
